How do you determine if a member has retired from the Pension Plan or Investment Plan?

FRS members who begin receiving monthly retirement benefits from the FRS Pension Plan or take any distribution from the FRS Investment Plan are considered retired and are subject to the reemployment after retirement provisions. To determine whether an employee is eligible for rehire, the following steps should be taken:

- **Pension Plan**: To determine if a member is retired under the FRS Pension Plan, call the Division of Retirement's Retired Payroll Unit at (850) 488-4742. You will need the member's name and Social Security number.
- Investment Plan: To determine if a member is retired under the FRS Investment Plan call the MyFRS Employer Assistance Line at 1-866-377-2121, and select Option 3. Identify yourself and your agency and provide the member's name and Social Security number. The representative can only tell you if the member took a distribution and the date of the distribution. They cannot tell you the payment type or amount, or any other information. You can also log on to the Employer site on MyFRS.com and determine the date the member received a distribution from the FRS Investment Plan (see a sample screenshot below).
