FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 22, 2017, the Presiding Officer submitted her Order on Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss (“Order”) to the State Board of Administration (“SBA”) in this proceeding. After the matter had been referred to the Presiding Officer, the employer of the pro se Petitioner, Rhonda Platt, changed Petitioner’s date of termination. As such, the second election form filed by Petitioner to join the Florida Retirement System Investment Plan became valid under applicable law. Thus, Petitioner has received the relief she sought in her petition for hearing, and there is no controversy remaining to resolve. A copy of the Order, recommending that the matter be dismissed, is attached hereto as Exhibit A. The matter is now pending before the Chief of Defined Contribution Programs for final agency action.

ORDERED

The Order on Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss (Exhibit A) is hereby adopted in its entirety. The Petitioner’s petition for a hearing is dismissed.

Any party to this proceeding has the right to seek judicial review of the Final Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration in the Office of the General Counsel, State Board of Administration, 1801 Hermitage Boulevard, Suite 100, Tallahassee, Florida, 32308, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days from the date the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration.



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
