FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 3, 2020, the Petitioner, Lamont Houston, filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal (“Notice”) with prejudice with the Division of Administrative Hearings (“DOAH”). In response to the Notice, Administrative Law Judge Jodi-Ann V. Livingstone entered, on August 3, 2020, an Order Closing File and Relinquishing Jurisdiction back to the SBA, which is attached as Exhibit A. The matter is now pending before the Chief of Defined Contribution Programs for final agency action.

ORDERED

This Final Order of Dismissal is entered dismissing the Petitioner’s case, based on Petitioner’s voluntary withdrawal of his Petition for Hearing that initiated the case.

Any party to this proceeding has the right to seek judicial review of the Final Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration in the Office of the General Counsel, State Board of

Administration, 1801 Hermitage Boulevard, Suite 100, Tallahassee, Florida, 32308, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days from the date the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration.


