### FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 17, 2017, the Petitioner, Julie Gaffney, and the Respondent, State Board of Administration ("SBA"), filed a Joint Motion for a Recommended Order of Dismissal Based on Withdrawal of Petition ("Joint Motion") with the Division of Administrative Hearings ("DOAH"). Petitioner had filed her Petition to challenge the SBA's denial of her request to be placed back into the FRS Pension Plan. Petitioner had defaulted into the Pension Plan in 2008. In 2014, she filed a Second Election Form to transfer to the Investment Plan. Petitioner claimed she had not received documentation that she had been enrolled in the Investment Plan since she had an incorrect mailing address on file. She further indicated that she had received nothing to show how the switch to the Investment Plan could negatively impact her retirement plan account balance, and that she was otherwise misled about the impact of the switch. However, a recording of a telephone call Petitioner made to the MyFRS Financial Guidance Line indicated that the differences between the Pension Plan, the Investment Plan and the Hybrid Plan had been explained during the call. In response to the Joint Motion, DOAH entered, on January 18, 2017, an Order Closing File and Relinquishing Jurisdiction back

to the SBA, which is attached as Exhibit A. The matter is now pending before the Chief of Defined Contribution Programs for final agency action.

### <u>ORDERED</u>

This Final Order of Dismissal is entered closing this matter based on Petitioner's voluntary withdrawal of her Petition for Hearing that initiated the case. The parties have agreed to cover their own attorneys' fees and costs incurred.

Any party to this proceeding has the right to seek judicial review of the Final Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration in the Office of the General Counsel, State Board of Administration, 1801 Hermitage Boulevard, Suite 100, Tallahassee, Florida, 32308, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days from the date the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration.
