FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 11, 2016, the Presiding Officer submitted her Recommended Order of Dismissal to the State Board of Administration in this proceeding. Petitioner was hired by a Florida Retirement System ("FRS")-participating employer, and was given a deadline of January 29, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. EST to make an initial election between the FRS Pension Plan and the FRS Investment Plan. It initially appeared that there was no record showing that Petitioner had timely made an initial election into the FRS Investment Plan. However, a subsequent examination of Petitioner's recorded calls to the MyFRS Financial Guidance line did demonstrate that Petitioner had expressed a desire to elect the FRS Investment Plan at 3:46 pm on January 29, 2016, fourteen (14) minutes before her election deadline. As such, her election request is being processed and a hearing is now moot. A copy of the Recommended Order of Dismissal is attached hereto as Exhibit A. The matter is now pending before the Senior Defined Contribution Programs Officer for final agency action.

<u>ORDERED</u>

The Recommended Order of Dismissal (Exhibit A) hereby is adopted in its entirety. The case is most and the Petitioner's Petition for Hearing hereby is dismissed.

Any party to this proceeding has the right to seek judicial review of the Final Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration in the Office of the General Counsel, State Board of Administration, 1801 Hermitage Boulevard, Suite 100, Tallahassee, Florida, 32308, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days from the date the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration.
